





UNPACK THE DILEMMA




Central to this world is a new face for Williams; coincidental criminality in the form of a twenty-something, groomed to be a professional thief - Eric Hayes.






Williams gathers info on Eric, which points him upstream to bigger fish until suddenly he's marked a 'dirty cop'.


He is currently the Executive Producer at PACRIM MEDIA.


PHIL WILLIAMS **Consulting Producer**

He was then assigned to Special Project Narcotics, the Metro Fugitive Squad at the U.S. Marshall's Service, and eventually into a special task force of the U.S. Secret Service for specific cases.


He has been recognized with a Medal for Meritorious Conduct for his detective work on a case netting 75 arrests. His other duty awards and accolades are numerous.

ELLIOT DAVIS Cinematographer



